Dublin Operatic Society

1928—1949

Twenty-one years ago, on the 24th June, 1928, to be precise, the Dublin Operatic Society was founded by Mrs. John Cavalier Adams, C. V. with the cooperation of Mr. T. S. C. Dwyer, on the purpose of producing Grand Operas, and with this intention ever before it during the ensuing years the Dublin Operatic Society has spent no effort in an endeavour to produce Grand Operas in a manner worthy of the classical traditions of Dublin.

In its early years under the expert guidance of its first Musical Director, Martin Vinn, the Society increased and presented with great artistic success operas which were rarely, if ever, heard in Dublin, including "La Sonnambula," "L'elisir d'Amour," "The Bohemians," and "The Great Escape," and more than 100 amateur singers, most of them students.

With the progress of the years these activities were introduced, this movement created personal interest in the Society which by the high standard of its productions would give every indication that it had firmly established itself as one of the features of musical Dublin.

The Society was re-constituted in June, 1939, and again in June, 1945, and is at present under the management of a most energetic and efficient Committee, who, since their assumption of office, have presented many seasons of Operas which were very successful, both financially and artistically.
